Communication and Language

Settling in and getting to know the adults that will be working in the classroom. Letters and sounds activities – s,a,t,pi,n,l,m,n,d,g,o,c,k,ck,e,u,r,h,b,ff,ll,ss We will blend and segment using these sounds to enable us to read and write simple phonetic words. We will practice key words or tricky words.
Role play home corner – birthdays, celebrations, dressing and undressing babies.
Listen to a variety of stories. Discuss themes throughout them and use them to support our learning.
Talk about personal experiences in class and group times. Use imaginative talk in role play, small world and puppet play.
Encourage use of the reading areas inside and outside.

Literacy

Singing rhymes and looking at rhyming vocabulary.
Letters and sounds – reading and writing simple sentences using words that are phonetic as well as tricky words.
Write own name ensuring letters are formed correctly.
Practise forming letters in sand, gloop, mud, paint etc.
Labels and captions for parts of the body. Write simple sentences about the body, ourselves and our news.
Writing birthday cards and invitations to celebrate birthday in our role play area.
Make small zig-zag books about growing from a baby to a grandparent in writing area.
